Tchaikovsky was deeply inspired by Shakespeare's writing, and in later years composed other works for The Tempest and Hamlet On November 6, 1893 Tchaikovsky died in St Petersburg from cholera His compositions are some of the greatest works of the Romantic Era, including the 1812 Overture, March Slav, and The Nutcracker, which has become a Christmas season favorite Peter Ilyich Tchaikovsky
